- 'there is a lack of ...'
- I don't know if 'freshly graduates' is correct. I couldn't find any sentence examples. 'fresh graduates' might be the only correct form.
- It is better to use a comma after 'For example' when it comes at the beginning of a sentence.
- 'many universities who have tie-ups with...'
- When you use 'disagree that...', whatever comes after it is the thing that the subject of the sentences disagrees with.

Here's a sentence from the New York Times

"Activists and some commissioners disagree that the weapons are needed."

Your sentence in the essay with 'disagree that' (2<sup>nd</sup> body paragraph) seems to have made a mistake in this regard.

You could have said 'Many people disagree **by saying** that one should be...'

• It is not entirely clear how the supporting sentences in the second body paragraph support the main point.
