

The rendered bar graph elucidates the expenditure on hamburger, fish and chips and Pizza in the UK by ^{three} different income groups. The quantity of pay out is mentioned in million pound.

Overall, it is discernible from the graph that hamburger is preferred by masses in UK and have spent the most by high ~~ave~~ income and average income. However, fish & chips were favoured by low income family.

To begin, with high income people, they spent more money on hamburger which was about twice of fish ~~and~~ chips and pizza. Moreover, with average income people they ^{also} spent maximum amount of their income on hamburger which was about 8 pence more than the money they spent on fish & chips and double the pizza,

Furthermore with low income people there is switch in the position they like fish & chips as compared to other fast food items, so that's why they spent 17 pence on it and rest on hamburger and pizza amounting for 14 pence and ~~about~~ nearly 7 pence respectively.
